The five foreign nationals named above were released without charge or trial from the Political Security Prison in Sana'a on Saturday 16 December. The men, along with their families, are said to have been told to leave the country.

'Abdullah Mustaffa bin 'Abdul Rahim Aiob and Mohammed Illias bin 'Abdul Rahim Aiob had been released on Saturday 2 December but were re-arrested on Wednesday 13 December. They were held for three days until their release along with the other three men on Saturday.
