JOURNALIST LOSES FINAL ASYLUM APPEAL IN NORWAY

Genci Angjellari, an investigative journalist from Albania, and his family have lost their final challenge against their deportation from Norway to Albania.

Genci Angjellari, an investigative journalist from Albania, his wife, **Fatjona Angjellari**, and their 15-month-old daughter, **Sofi Angjellari**, registered a further appeal against their deportation in early December with Norwegian immigration authorities. On 14 December the Immigration Appeals Board issued a final refusal of their request to have their application for asylum reconsidered.

Genci Angjellari has informed Amnesty International that he and his family intend to cooperate now with Norwegian immigration authorities, and expressed his thanks to Amnesty International activists who took action.

Thank you to all those who sent appeals. No further action is requested from the UA network.
