COLOLMBIA: William Villalba

Amnesty International is concerned for the physical integrity of William Villalba who was last seen in Granada, department of Meta.

According to eye witnesses, William Villalba was siezed from an ice-cream parlour in the centre of Granada, department of Meta on 26 July 1992 by a group of armed men. He was pushed into a Toyota car and taken to an unidentified destination. Local military and police authorities have reportedly denied holding him and his whereabouts remain unknown.

William Willalba is a member of the legal left-wing coalition party <u>Unión</u> Patriótica, (UP), Patriotic Union.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Coinciding with an escalating offensive by the Colombian armed forces against the armed opposition group Fuerzas Armadas Revolucionarias de Colombia, (FARC), Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia, in the department of Meta, Amnesty International has received an increasing number of reports of human rights violations against non-combatant civilians by army personnel in areas undergoing counter-insurgency operations. Victims have frequently been leaders and members of the UP, who claim that over 1,500 of its members have been victims of politically motivated killings since its creation in 1985. The majority of these killings have been attributed by Colombian authorities to paramilitary groups which it claims it is unable to control. However, independent investigations, including judicial inquiries have concluded that many such groups operate under the command or with the support of the Colombian security forces.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters:

- expressing concern at the possible "disappearance" of William Villalba;
- urging that his legal situation be clarified and that he be treated humanely and allowed full access to family and lawyers;
